Properly organized and operating groups of KICK International members may apply to KICK International to obtain official recognition by KICK International as a recognized training academy, Instructor and / or coach of KICK International. In order to apply to be recognized as a training academy or Instructor of KICK International, a written request for recognition and affiliation must be prepared and submitted to KICK International at 483 S. Kirkwood Road suite 11 St. Louis, MO 63122, USA.

A United States applicant must provide the following information in a written application for recognition and affiliation:

The Instructor, school or club applying for recognition as an approved instructor/facility must:

1. Agree to abide by the Kick International rules and regulations as established and will follow the by-laws pertaining to members, organizational structure, and purposes and activities;
2. The applicant for the training academy must enroll at least ten (10) members in Kick International, all of whom must be current members in good standing of KICK International prior to final approval as a certified training academy;
3. Completion and acceptance of the organizational agreement that the applicant will abide by the business policies as provided by Kick International for its established coaching and training as provided through the coaches training seminar system.
4. Completion of or proof of a current First Aid and CPR certification through CPR on line accreditation, or KICK International seminar service, and become a member in good standing with a chapter of the National Youth Sports Coaches Organization and submit to a background check.
5. Confirmation that the applicant will comply with the KICK International Operations Manual – Subsidiary Affiliated Organizations, which is available through KICK International.

A copy of this application must be forwarded to KICK INTERNATIONAL or your regional representative for recommendation.

Countries or organizations wishing to participate and become an affiliate of KICK International must:

The international organization must be open to all interested participants, and all organizations offering martial Arts / kickboxing. All organizations claiming representation for kickboxing within a country must be represented if the home country does not offer governmental certification and official documentation as a national governing body. KICK International may only be represented by a legal entity only representing amateur sports.

1. Submit a formal request of affiliation and provide proof of State or Country certified representation.
2. No fees are to be sent to the United States headquarters until all registrations and documentation is complete. There are no affiliation fees for not-for-profit recognized and registered organizations.
3. Upon approval the State or County requesting representation shall receive documented proof of representation of Kick International
4. Each organization approved for country recognition which does not meet the requirements for a not for profit recognized organization must submit annual membership association dues of three hundred dollars on January 1 of each year or at the time of acceptance, for licensing and updated rules, certification and international legal standards.
5. Provide proof of medical coverage, quality of judging, refereeing, and overall officiating adequate to meet the standards of KICK International.
6. Adhere to the rules of Kick International competition in their entirety.
7. Each country must submit a delegate to represent their progress.
8. Each country must maintain detailed competition and medical records.
9. Each country must abide by all required medical examinations for athletes and officials
10. Each athlete must be monitored for Drug abuse, both coaches and athletes will be held responsible for adherence to International rules as outlined by the KICK International Drug Abuse review committee.
11. Recommended Regional Coaches, Judges and Referees will be invited to the United States for annual events and cross training.
12. Approved and affiliated countries will be contacted for requirement in International competitions Interested Country sports authority representative may present their documents and request by submitting all information on line to kickusa@earthlink.net for consideration and evaluation.
